



## ARTIST EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

### Maryborough Story Trail Bronze Sculptures

The Maryborough Story Trail project aims to create a unique cultural tourism experience that shares the stories, old and new, of our city. These sculptures will be Phase 2 of an ongoing project involving the creation of a public arts and cultural trail that links the Heritage CBD and Portside precincts.

A key method used to tell Maryborough's stories is the production of artworks.

Council seeks expressions of interest from suitably qualified bronze sculptors to produce 5 bronze artworks. The artworks will be small to medium in size and sit on a concrete plinth to be situated outdoors.

#### Applicants are invited to provide:

- Examples of previous work
- Artists CV
- Costs of previous artworks
- An estimate for the production of 2 bronze sculptures, approx. 40cm x 20cm.  
(This is to include all costs associated with producing a bronze artwork, including design, production and footings. Installation should be excluded from the price as a local contractor will manage installation.)

The selected bronze sculptor(s) will be required to liaise and work closely with Council's Arts and Cultural Officers. The artist will be provided with stories and asked to develop an artist's interpretation prior to commencing development of the bronze sculpture.

Once the artist's concept has been approved, the artist will be given approval to commence.

**The bronze artist must provide weekly updates to Council's Arts and Cultural Officers. This includes progress photos.**

**The artwork must be completed and delivered by 30 Oct 2019.**
