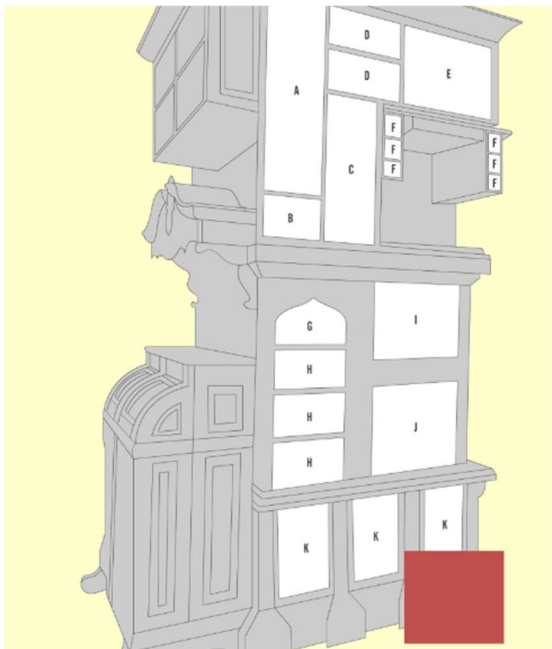


Name: The creation of painted back drops for dioramas in the Cabinet of Curiosities.

Concept: A series of small dioramas will be created and inserted into the cabinet of curiosities, a purpose built cabinet with many draws (see image below). Within some of these draws dioramas will be created and discovered by people as they open the draws. Council is seeking an artist to create the miniature painted back drops for the dioramas.



The Cabinet of Curiosities

Location: To be on display at the Maryborough Story Bank

Specifications :

The following back drops will need to be painted onto thick cardboard, mdf, canvas on board or similar (to be negotiated with the successful applicant. Applicant should state their preferred material in their application).

1. 37cm x 22cm – picture of park and sky
2. 90cm x 30cm – night sky with Mary Poppins and swirling stars
3. 36cm x 22cm – chalk artwork on concrete
4. 11.5cm x 36cm – trees and park
5. 10cm x 10cm – night sky
6. 43.5cm x 40.5cm – gardens
7. 57cm x 47.5cm – Admiral Booms ship home

Style: The artwork should be painted in a realistic, representational style. Artists should be confident working in a small format.

Considerations: The artist will need to develop concept sketches prior to commencement of the artworks.

Application process: Please provide the following prior to due date:

- Examples of past work
- Indicative quote for completion of the back drops. This includes materials.
