

Name Interactive Bookcases

Concept These bookcases will be the feature of the Inspiration Room, to create the feel of an old English library. The room itself will be designed to capture the people and places that influenced PL Travers.

Two (2) corner bookcases will be constructed to replicate traditional English or French furniture types, combining innovative design with intriguing mechanical devices.

The shelves must incorporate interactive elements and overall theme of curiosity (see “Theme” below).

Included in shelves should be a display stand for a large book, interactive ‘hide holes’ and provision to display small-scale installations amongst the books. Allow for curiosity and exploration. See link below for reference.

Shelves H 350mm

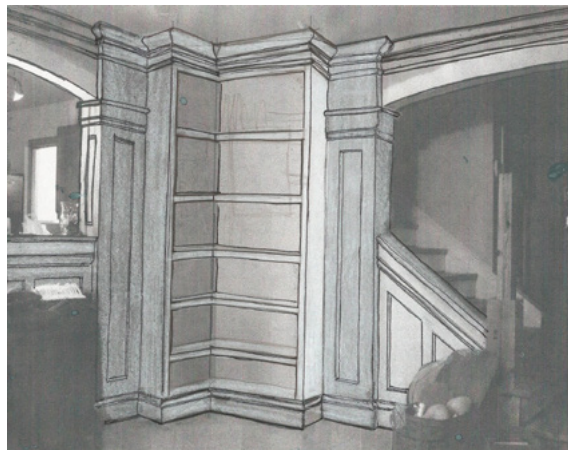
- Site**
